

## Things to Know About Game Day

- **Player hygiene** – the easiest way to reduce risk of infection is to practice good personal hygiene and social distancing.
  - **If you or your child are sick STAY HOME.**
  - **Stay at least 6 ft apart from anyone not in your household.**
  - **Facemasks are recommended for anyone moving between fields.**
  - **Wash hands anytime you use the restroom.**
  - **No spitting or sunflower seeds for players, coaches or spectators**
  - **As soon as players arrive at their game field they will be required to sanitize their hands. They will not be allowed on the field until they do so. There will be hand sanitizer in each dugout.**
- **Practices** – Through the rest of the season teams will not have a dedicated practice time and field because practice fields are now game fields. Coaches will schedule practices through a google form that will be sent out to coaches.
- **Postgame handshakes and postgame snacks** will not be allowed this year. One person could potentially infect an entire team within the 30 seconds. It's not worth the risk even if it is a small one.
- **Home team fans** will sit on the 1<sup>st</sup> base sideline. Bleachers will not be available. Bring a blanket or lawn chair and stay AT LEAST 6 feet away from those not in your household.
- **Away team fans** will sit on the 3<sup>rd</sup> base sideline. Bleachers will not be available. Bring a blanket or lawn chair and stay AT LEAST 6 feet away from those not in your household.
- **Water** – bring your own water bottle as water fountains will not be available. Players should never share water bottles, especially this year.
- **After your team's game** please leave the facility directly. Absolutely do not mingle with parents or players from the other team.
- **Game Time Limits** – all games will have a hard time limit. When the time limit is reached the batter will finish his/her at bat and the game will be over regardless of the game situation.
- **Jerseys** will be delivered to each team at their first game.
- **Line Ups** – all players will bat in the lineup even if they are not in the field. Players who are late will be put at the bottom of the line-up.
- **Dugouts** The **Tee Ball and Coach Pitch divisions** will sit with their parents when their team is batting. There will not be dugout benches.
- Players in the **machine pitch, A and AA divisions** will be spaced out in their team's dugout. Home team has the 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout. Away team will have the 3<sup>rd</sup> base dugout.
- Each team will use their own set of **baseballs/softballs** when they are on defense.
- Players need to bring their own **helmet and glove** to every game and every practice. DO NOT share these with teammates.
